



# CFR ICE FISHING CONTEST RULES

In an effort to run a successful tournament with everyone leaving satisfied, we have developed a short list of rules and regulations for our tournament. Some have become necessary based on experiences from previous tournaments while others are guidelines we have gleaned from participation in other tournaments. ## FISHING

- All participants **MUST** be registered by the start of the tournament.
- All fish must be measured at the measuring station on the ice near The Rock.
- All fish **WILL** be measured by CFR personnel/volunteers.
- Measurements **WILL** be made using CFR provided equipment.
- ALL measurements as determined by the measurer are final – no exceptions.
- Any evidence of mutilating a fish in order to extend its length **WILL** result in disqualification.
- Any participants who wish to participate in the catch and release drawing **MUST** release their fish at the measuring station – no exceptions.
- All fish must be caught during tournament times (8am – 5pm on Saturday Feb. 11, 2023) and must be alive when registered.
- All fish must be caught on Lake Alexander
- All fish to be registered **MUST** be of legal size.
- All fishing must follow the laws, rules and regulations pertaining to the species and body of water as published by the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources.

## RAFFLES/PRIZES/WINNERS

- Winners of card raffles or double roll ticket raffles **MUST** be present to win. All winning numbers will be read at least 3 times before discarding that ticket and choosing another winner. It is the entrant's responsibility to be present during the drawing.
- Fish prizes are determined by length in each category. If two winning fish are registered with the same length, the first fish registered will get the prize.
  - Example: If three fish are registered in a given category one 18" and two that are 17.5" the first 17.5" fish registered will get 2<sup>nd</sup> place and the other will get 3<sup>rd</sup> place.
  - Example 2: If four fish are registered in a given category one at 18", one at 17" and two at 16" the 18" will get 1<sup>st</sup> prize, the 17" second prize, the first 16" registered will get 3<sup>rd</sup> prize and the last 16" registered will not receive a prize.
- If only one fish is registered in a category, the person who registered that fish will receive all three prizes for that category.
- If two fish are registered in a category, the people who registered those fish will win their perspective prizes AND split third prize evenly.
- **NEW FOR 2023** On all card raffles **ONLY** CFR personnel and volunteers are allowed to "rip" or cut the cards in half.
- For any odd or unforeseen circumstances that may arise during the course of the tournament and raffles CFR personnel will determine the outcome. All decisions in these cases are final.
